Based in Vancouver, BC, the Digestion Technician position performs duties related to the digestion and fusion of geological samples and other tasks as assigned by the supervisor. This position is available for morning shift (7am to 3pm), afternoon shift (3-11pm) or night shift (11pm to 7am). Flexible part time shifts are also available. Working overtime and weekends may be required as needed.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Ensure fast and accurate processing of incoming samples in priority sequence.
- Digest samples according to written procedure without deviation unless authorized in writing by the Geochemistry Manager or Assistant Geochem Manager
- Prepare and document preparation of reagents according to written procedure without deviation
- Perform and document quality checks at all stages of sample and material handling, halting production where necessary by Hold card and reporting problems/issues to the Supervisor.
- Operate, maintain and ensure calibration records are kept for equipment according to written instruction.
- Comply with all company policies, occupational safety regulations, laboratory safety procedures, and requirements of applicable ISO Quality System SOPs
- Other duties or tasks as assigned from time to time
